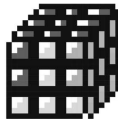

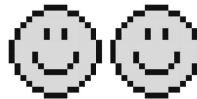

 Enjoy a sensory-friendly family concert with celebrated modern folk duo Dan and Claudia Zanes. Rain location: Auditorium.

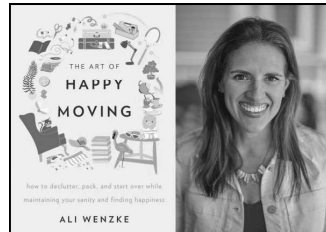
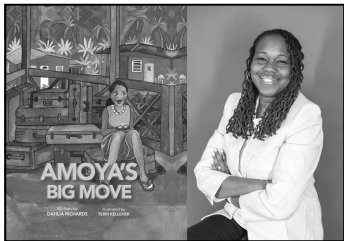


Scales & Tales Traveling Zoo
