Qualifications: You must be entering grades 9-12 this fall. You should like children and books, and be friendly and dependable. Finally, you should be available to volunteer at least 16 hours (eight 2-hour shifts) between June 20 and August 12. These two-hour shifts are Monday through Friday between 10 AM and 4 PM.

Volunteers will need to attend a training session and must show proof of vaccination. You can receive credit for service hours if needed.
