

Annual Report FY 2019-2020


Friends of the Wilmette Public Library in 2019-2020:

- Friends support library programming and events for the Wilmette and Kenilworth communities. Funds to support programming are generated from memberships, donations, and sales of gently used books at Books Down Under, the Friends' bookstore. The bookstore is staffed and supported by dedicated volunteers. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Friends' funded programming shifted from in-person to virtual, while much of the normal programming and excess inventory donations paused. Books Down Under had to cease operations and close.
- Friends normally fund the Library's annual community-wide reading program, One Book Everyone Reads, held each spring. Unfortunately, the 2020 One Book Everyone Reads did not occur. We look forward to the return of this annual popular community program.
